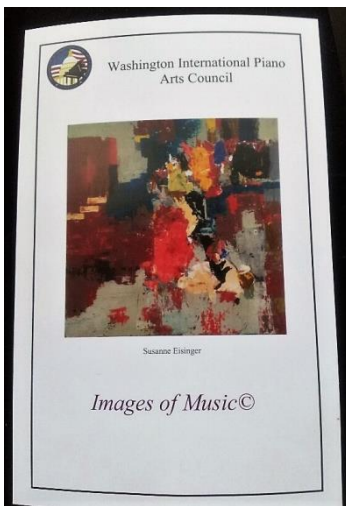


# *“Images of Music”*
